Global X Resolve Adaptive Asset Allocation Corporate Class ETF (formerly, Horizons ReSolve Adaptive Asset Allocation ETF) (HRAA)

The Global X Resolve Adaptive Asset Allocation Corporate Class ETF is an alternative mutual fund whose investment objective is to seek long-term capital appreciation by investing, directly or indirectly, in major global asset classes including but not limited to equity indices, fixed income indices, interest rates, commodities and currencies. HRAA gains exposure to these asset classes by investing in derivative instruments that may include futures contracts and forward agreements, and securities. HRAA primarily held future contracts for the period from July 1, 2023 to June 30, 2024. Futures do not have annual shareholder meetings or require voting by the participants in general.

For the period from July 1, 2023 to June 30, 2024, there were no proxy voting records to present.
